

While you start shopping for this year's school supplies we would like to recommend some art materials. Students will need their own individual art kits for learning virtually. When we eventually return in-school they won't be sharing supplies this year as a precaution to prevent the spread of germs. Your grade-level supply list already has some basics like pencils, erasers, crayons (I recommend Crayola brand), glue sticks, scissors, and markers (I recommend the washable Crayola brand).

Some additional supplies students will need for their art kits are:

- <u>Watercolor Paint Set</u>- They only need the 8 color tray. Please make sure it contains a paintbrush. We highly recommend the Prang brand watercolor tray. The Crayola brand is our next favorite. These can get used quickly, so be prepared to possibly replenish them later in the year.
- <u>Colored Pencils</u>- Same with the markers and crayons, the 8 or 12 pack is plenty. <u>Crayola</u> is our recommended brand. However others will work just fine too!
- White Drawing Paper –Copy works fine for drawing, but a thicker paper will be best for painting.
- Colored Construction Paper- optional, its good to have just in case we need it.
- <u>Plastic Cups</u>- For water while painting. You can use old sour cream tubs and things like that.
- <u>Newspaper/Table Covers</u>- To protect the workspace.

As the year goes on there might be more specific items students need. We will keep you updated on those. This is uncharted territory we are entering.
