

# Becoming A Ready Graduate

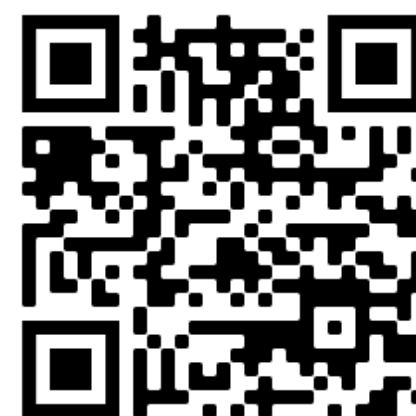
