Rewards for following the rules:



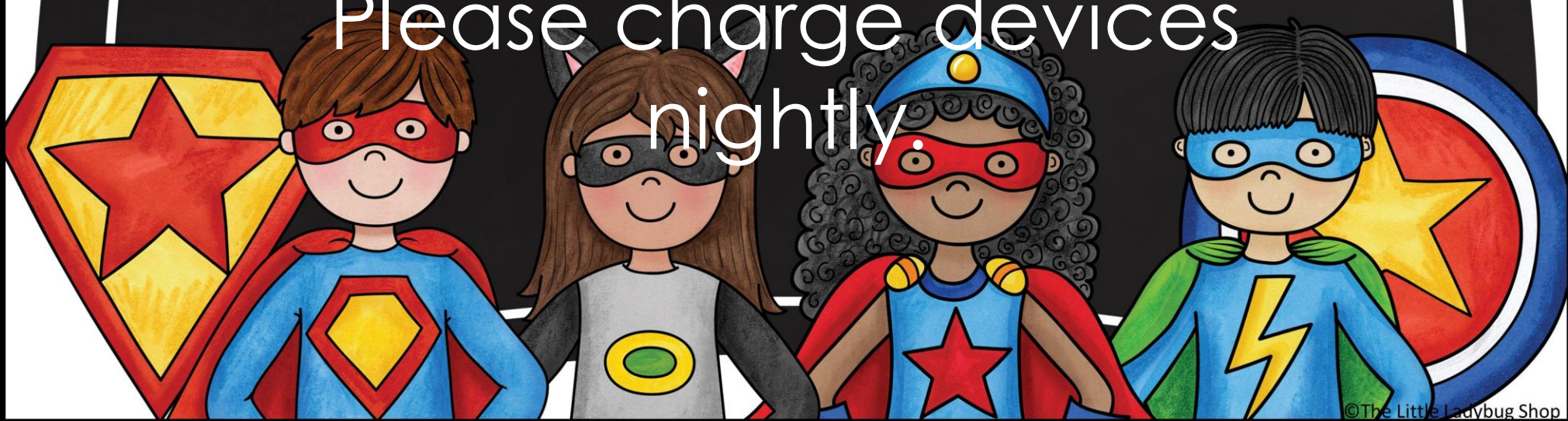
