Continue to follow the guidance from the handout you received last week

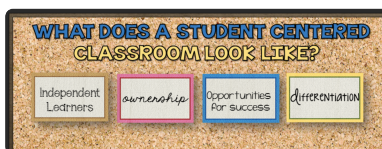
If you feel that you still need support with accessing and implementing ReThink, please see the information below.
