 - Read the daily agenda posted on the board. Please have your materials ready to go: assignment, pencil, calculator, computer charged, etc.
- Station Rotation: Procedures will be discussed when stations are being utilized and can change depending on the activities.
- Make-up work: If you are absent, it is your responsibility to make up all the work that you missed.
