

# What is Title 1?

**Title 1** is a federal program which provides additional funds above and beyond the funds provided to every Memphis-Shelby County School. The funds are provided to schools that have a certain percentage of socioeconomically disadvantaged students. Westwood High School is qualified to receive these federal funds.

Title I serves to ensure that all children have a fair, equal, and significant opportunity to obtain a high-quality education and reach, at a minimum, proficiency on challenging state academic achievement standards and state academic assessments.


