Topic 1: Understand Multiplication and Division of Whole Numbers

Dear Families,

We are beginning Topic 1 in our enVision Mathematics curriculum, and we're excited to dive into the foundational concepts of multiplication and division!



What We're Learning:

- Understand multiplication as repeated addition and equal groups
- Learn division as sharing and grouping
- Use models like arrays and number lines to show understanding
- Explore the relationship between multiplication and division
- Begin to build fact fluency with basic multiplication facts



How You Can Help at Home:

- Practice skip counting by 2s, 5s, and 10s
- Use real-life examples (e.g., "We have 3 bags with 4 apples in each. How many apples total?")
- Ask your child to explain how they solved a multiplication or division problem
- Use everyday objects (toys, snacks, etc.) to make equal groups and share items evenly



Topic 1 Vocabulary:

- Multiply – To find the total number of items in equal-sized groups
- Divide – To split a number into equal parts or groups
- Array – A set of objects arranged in rows and columns
- Equal groups – Groups that have the same number of objects
- Repeated addition – Adding the same number again and again
- Number line – A line on which numbers are marked at equal intervals
