

Summer Reading Bookmark

Attention Rising 4th Graders!

Your 3rd grade teachers have just gotten word that you have been reading like a machine this summer! We've been told that in fact you already finished your first reading log and you are on a personal mission to finish enough books to dry your printer's ink cartridge out.

Now is time for your next mission which might be the toughest yet. You must choose your FAVORITE BOOK you read this summer. (I know it's a tough choice so take your time making this decision.)

When you're ready to start your Reading bookmark follow these directions below!

1. Choose your favorite book you read this summer.
2. Get a piece of construction paper, cardboard, cardstock or any paper really and cut it into a GIANT rectangle.
The **bigger, the better.** You want it to be about 24 in. in length and 6 inches in width.
3. Write you book title, author and your name on the top.
4. Next, draw a picture of the main character or main characters and write their names underneath them.
5. Write down 4 character traits that describe your main character in a caption box underneath your illustration.
6. After that, write a one paragraph summary about your book.
Make sure you include the problem and solution!
7. Finally, decorate your bookmark how ever you like, it's yours!
8. Give yourself a high five on a job well done and go read your next book!
