PURPOSE OF THE MEETING



Title 1

- Title one is the largest federal assistance program for our nation's schools.
- The goal of Title 1 is a higher quality of education for every child.
 - The program serves millions of children in elementary and secondary schools each year.



How Title 1 Works

- ❖ The federal government provides funding to states based on Census data each year for Title 1
- ❖ The Tennessee Department of Education sends the money to the local school districts.
- ❖ The school district identifies eligible schools (based on Free and Reduced lunch percentages) and provides Title 1 funds.
 - ❖ All Title 1 schools in SCS implement a schoolwide program.

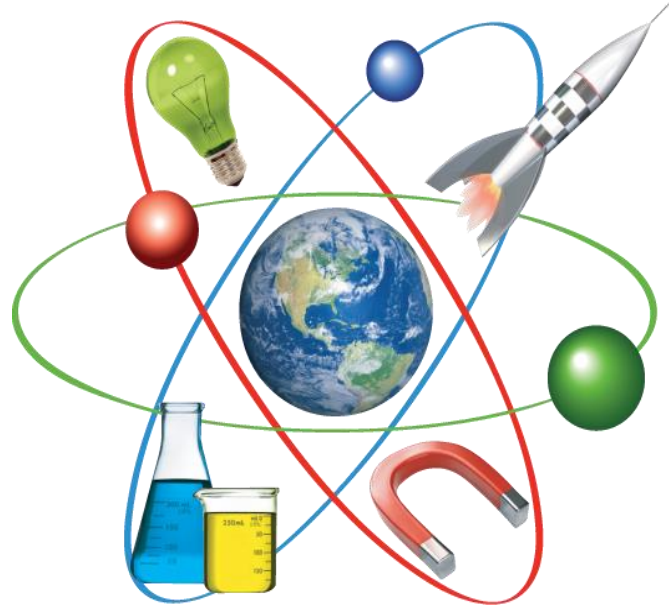

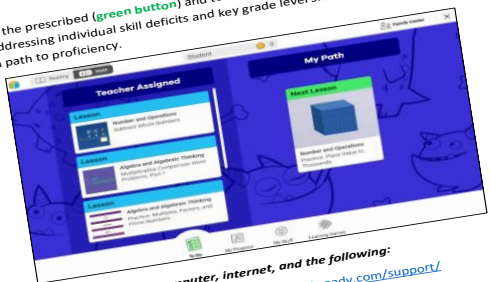
