

What is the purpose of the Tutoring Program? The program is designed to support students' academic needs and mitigate student learning loss.

What subjects will be offered during the tutoring sessions? Tutoring for students in grades K-8 will focus on English Language Arts or Math. Tutoring for students in grades 9 and 10 will focus on End-of-Course assessment subject areas. Tutoring for students in grades 11 and 12 will focus on ACT preparation.

Is transportation provided? It is not.

What if my child rides the bus? If a bus rider receives tutoring before school, the parent must drop them off at school and they may ride the bus home. If a bus rider receives after school tutoring, they may ride the bus to school, but the parent must pick them up from school at the conclusion of each tutoring session.

Is the tutoring in-person or virtual? It is in-person.

When are the tutoring sessions? Students attend three 1-hour sessions per week (Monday, Tuesday, and Thursday) and one Saturday session per month from 9 a.m. to noon.



How will students who currently attend YMCA or Extended Learning Program (ELP) receive tutoring? Tutoring will be offered to these students during their regularly scheduled before and after care programs.

Is there a fee? No, there is no cost for tutoring.
