Virtual Learning

- SCS Superintendent, Dr. Joris Ray, mandated that all SCS schools will deliver instruction virtually until further notice.
- Instruction will be delivered online via Microsoft Teams and Microsoft products.
- The district is providing all students an electronic device.
 - Pick Up Here at Southwind
 - 8a-6p (Wednesday – Friday); 8a-1p (Saturday).
 - Power up the device before the first day of school



Virtual Bell Schedule

- All instruction will be synchronous, meaning it will be live face-to-face instruction.
- Students must log-in on or before 8:00 AM, and they will log off at 3:00 PM.
- To be early is to be on time; to be on time is to be late. To be late is unacceptable.
- Students should log in ten minutes before school starts and return on-time to class from each learning break.
- Students must be logged into their classes for the entire class period.



Virtual Bell Schedule

- The schedule is a seven-period school day.
- There are four scheduled learning breaks for students.
 - Office hours (2) - where they can seek advisement from teachers on academics or log off their devices for a learning break
 - Must return to learning on-time.
 - School Announcements - where the students can receive daily announcements, they must remain logged in.
 - Lunch - students will have a thirty-minute lunch break; they can log off for lunch.

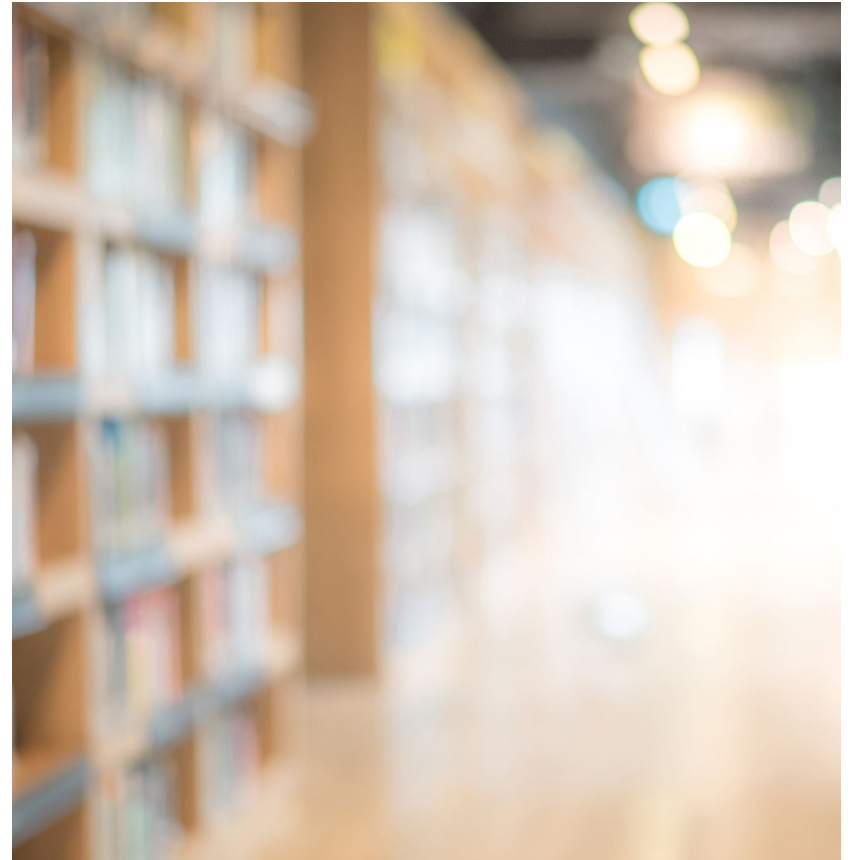
SCS Grading Policy

- Students will have **AT LEAST 17** grades per nine-weeks (quarter).
- Students must have **AT LEAST 8** grades for progress reports.
- Categories:
 - Homework: 10% (minimum of 4 grades)
 - Class Participation: 5% (minimum of 4 grades)
 - Classwork: 35% (minimum of 4 grades)
 - Projects/Portfolios/Presentations: 10% (minimum of 1 grade)
 - Assessments: 40% (minimum of 4 grades)

Semester Grades are determined by counting two quarter grades (85%) and the semester exam (15%).

School Learning Expectations

- **Virtual Student Code of Conduct**
 - **Directs student work environment**
 - **Provide guidance on expected student behavior while engaged in virtual learning**
 - **SCS Policy 6022 – lists the disciplinary infractions.**
 - **SCS Policy 6022 – issues disciplinary consequences during virtual learning.**

School Learning Expectations

- **School supply lists will be provided by the individual teachers on their course syllabi.**
 - **Course syllabi will be given the first day of school.**
- **Students will have a course syllabus that will provide information on teacher contact, digital citizenship expectations, student grades, makeup work policy, and course expectations.**
