## **Student Academic Supports**

Parents, in our support of our students, our teachers have stepped up in a big way to ensure that no student is left behind during this season of virtual learning. Listed below are academic supports that we are offering students who need academic support.

- Teacher After School Office Hours
  - All teachers at Southwind HS have virtual office hours one day a week after school to provide tutoring and learning assistance for all students. There are links on the school website for students to access their teacher's office hours.
- School Counselor Support
  - If a student is experiencing academic difficulty, parent teacher conferences are still a viable option to speak with teachers to provide solutions for academic success. All parents can request parent-teacher conferences

by requesting them through the <u>SHS</u> <u>School Counseling Website</u>.

- Homework Hotline
  - Shelby County Schools has an after hours tutorial service for student academic help with homework.
    Students and parents can call 901-416-1234, or they may access the service from the <u>district website</u>. This service is available from 3 PM - 8 PM (Monday-Thursday). Tutoring is available through the phone and virtually online.
- ACT Support

 Students who need ACT support can receive support by signing up for the district Saturday Academy. All high school students in grades 9-12 can receive support to prepare them for the ACT. The deadline for the November 14, 2020 session is this

#### **School and District Updates**

- Return Stronger: January 19, 2021
  - Superintendent Dr. Joris Ray has indicated that schools will begin the process of reopening schools virtually or in-person for high school students on January 19, 2021.
  - Schools will only reopen for hybrid learning based solely upon the COVID-19 conditions in Shelby County, Tennessee.
  - 0 As a part of this plan, the district has given parents until this Friday, November 6, 2020 to determine your learning option for the remainder of the school year. You only have to make a change if and only if you plan to change the learning option made at the beginning of the year. For example, if your student is virtual currently and you want them to come back for in-person learning in January or vice versa, you must log into PowerSchool to change your selection. If you are not changing your option, you do not have to make a change on PowerSchool.
  - We will be seeking feedback from parents and providing more information about our school's return stronger plan.

  - The Tennessee Promise scholarship deadline has been extended. As of right now, 97% of our seniors have applied for this honor. This scholarship provides students with free tuition to one of Tennessee's community colleges.
