- 1) Online (Youtube, Univision- news program "Al Punto" con Jorge Ramos, BBC Mundo, TED talks, from EMC School Publishing for Culture material in video, song, news and travel <a href="http://iculture.emcl.com">http://iculture.emcl.com</a> password: ICULTURE4U, etc.), watch/listen to 6 segments or interviews in Spanish, related to each of the 6 AP themes for the year: Personal and Public Identities, Family and Communities, Contemporary Life, Beauty and Aesthetics, Global Challenges, and Science and Technology. For each audio/video, write a brief summary (in English) telling the overall idea with at least 2-3 supporting details, from only your own comprehension. It's important to choose from a variety of Spanish-speaking countries mainly for exposure to different accents. \*Mark each with the title of the theme (of the 6 above) to which it relates.
- 2) In The Ultimate Spanish Review and Practice workbook (the one recommended), or the like, study the <u>Future tense with "will"</u> and complete A-D exercises, pgs. 71-74. Study the <u>Conditional</u> and complete H-J exercises, pgs. 77-80. Study <u>Reflexive verbs</u> on pgs. 82-83 and complete exercise A, E, F, H and I on pgs. 85-88. Study the <u>Present Perfect</u> and complete A, B and E exercises, pgs. 108-111. All exercises must be handwritten and legible. Nothing typed will be accepted (2 grades worth).
