

ADVANCED PLACEMENT DRAWING AND 2-D PORTFOLIO REQUIREMENTS AND SUMMER ASSIGNMENT REQUIREMENTS:

DESCRIPTION OF THE CLASSES:

BOTH THE A.P. **DRAWING PORTFOLIO** AND THE A.P. **2-D DESIGN PORTFOLIO** REQUIRE THE ART STUDENT TO **CREATE A SERIES OF WORKS BASED ON A THEME** OR A COMMON CONCEPT. THE THEME OR AREA OF INVESTIGATION IS ILLUSTRATED BY THE CREATION OF A MINIMUM OF 15 ORIGINAL WORKS REFERED TO AS AN **“EXTENDED INVESTIGATION”** OR **“CONCENTRATION”**.

THE 15 WORKS ARE THEN PHOTOGRAPHED AND DIGITALLY SENT TO BE GRADED BY THE COLLEGE BOARD AT THE END OF THE YEAR IN MAY.

AP DRAWING PORTFOLIO: CONSISTS OF MAINLY TRADITIONAL DRAWING AND PAINTING MEDIA=15 WORKS IN A SERIES.

AP 2-D PORTFOLIO: CONSISTS OF TRADITIONAL MEDIA AND/OR DIGITAL MEDIA. TYPICALLY TAKEN AS A 2ND YEAR= 15 WORKS IN A SERIES.

ALONG WITH THE ART, THE STUDENT IS EXPECTED TO WRITE ABOUT HOW THEIR ARTWORK EXPLORES THE ORIGINAL CONCEPT, AS WELL AS THE CREATIVE PROCESS. THERE IS AN ESSAY PORTION SUBMITTED WITH THE ART. INVESTIGATION INTO COMPOSITIONAL PRINCIPLES AND MASTER ARTISTS IS TYPICALLY INCLUDED IN THE ESSAY, ALONG WITH SPECIFICS OF MEDIA, TECHNIQUE AND FORMAT.

THE BASIS FOR BUILDING THE PORTFOLIO IS “OBSERVATIONAL ART”. STUDENTS ARE REQUIRED TO USE THE REAL WORLD AS A BASIS TO BUILD A PORTFOLIO. ONLY ORIGINAL IMAGERY THROUGH “DIRECT OBSERVATION” OR ORIGINAL PHOTOGRAPHS MAYBE USED.

THIS IS A TIME-INTENSIVE CLASS. IF YOU ARE DOING MULTIPLE AP CLASSES. MOST DEDICATED ART STUDENTS WILL TELL YOU IT TAKES A SIGNIFICANT AMOUNT OF TIME TO DEVELOP 15 COMPLETED WORKS THAT BELONG IN A SERIES AND ALSO WRITE ABOUT HOW YOU INVESTIGATED YOUR TOPIC.

TO BE APPROVED FOR THE CLASS:

-1 YEAR OF HIGH SCHOOL ART (“B” AVERAGE MINIMUM).

-A PORTFOLIO CONSISTING OF: MINIMUM (3) WORKS BASED AROUND A THEME, BASED IN OBSERVATION. ALSO INCLUDE 3 RANDOM WORKS BASED ON OBSERVATION.

-NO SIZE LIMITATION, NO MEDIUM LIMITATION. DO WHAT YOU DO BEST.

(IF YOU ARE SERIOUSLY INTERESTED IN BEING IN THE CLASS, BUT YOU LACK THE NUMBER OF WORKS REQUIRED, BE SURE TO TALK TO ME PERSONALLY!

- **DUE THE FIRST FRIDAY WE ARE BACK IN SESSION IN AUGUST.**

-SELECT AT LEAST A GENERAL THEME TO **CREATE 4 WORKS**.HAVE A MASTER ARTIST/S WHO DEALS IN A SIMILAR TOPIC.

-WORK MUST BE BASED ON AN **OBSERVATIONAL SUBJECT**, WITH A COMMON CONCEPT (**GOOGLE: AP ART CONCENTRATION IDEAS**).

-NO MEDIA RESTRICTIONS ALTHOUGH YOU SHOULD GO WITH YOUR STRONGEST MEDIUM TO BEGIN.

-SIZE: 9" X 12" OR ANY SIZE LARGER—FEEL FREE TO DO IN A SKETCHBOOK.

-**MUST BE 4 FINISHED COMPOSITIONS**. PLEASE NO STUDIES (A STUDY IS A SINGLE SUBJECT, PLACED IN THE CENTER OF A COMPOSITION). PLEASE USE ACCURATE DETAIL AND COMPLETE CHIAROSCURO, WITH FULL VALUE VARIETY WITH ANY MEDIUM YOU SELECT.-SELECT A TOPIC YOU HAVE EVERYDAY ACCESS TO, IN ORDER TO OBSERVE AND/OR PHOTOGRAPH REGULARLY.
