

### Spanish 3 H. Summer assignment (optional)

This is strongly recommended to keep up with and improve many of the skills necessary in speaking and learning another language, and an opportunity for up to 3 extra credit points on your 1<sup>st</sup> OR 2<sup>nd</sup> quarter average. On Youtube, Spotify, etc., do a search for a number of authentic songs in Spanish (not Spanish versions of songs in English). You might want to ask around or google Hispanic artists for the genre that you prefer. Choose 2-3 songs to learn (you must be attracted to the rhythm/lyrics in order to make it easier and more enjoyable to learn). As you learn each song, also, do your own translation of the lyrics, enough to write a summary of the song's story line. Write a list of all new vocabulary to you (nouns, adjectives and verbs) for each song separately. Make a video collage of YOU singing along all songs, mimicking the correct pronunciation! (Your face must show during the entire video. If you haven't truly learned the songs, it'll show...). Include at least 2/3 of each song and include or announce the title (with English translation) and artist for each.
