## Activity Task for Week of 4/20/20

4.RL.KID.1 Refer to details and examples in a text when explaining what the text says explicitly; refer to details and examples in a text when drawing inferences from the text.

Pick a story book that you have in your house that you have NOT read, or pick one that you like if you can't find one. You should read the first chapter and then do the following:

- 1) Make a chart with two sides; I notice / I wonder. For the first half, write down what you "notice," and in the second half write down what you "wonder." We teachers picked Harry Potter and the Sorcerer's Stone for his examples:
  - a. EX: "I notice Harry Potter lives in a closet at his Aunt and Uncle's"
  - b. EX: "I wonder why he lives in there and not in a normal bedroom?"
- 2) You will then write the <u>Gist or Main Idea</u> and what you can *infer* from the first chapter only. This should look like 1-2 paragraphs total if you write the Gist and what you Infer.

Materials for this activity are a piece of paper, a book in your house, and your own smart brains. Have fun with this students!
