Re: Parents' Right To Know

Parents,

We thank you for being an integral part of our Oakshire team. We are working really hard daily to ensure that your child receives the best education possible. We do want you to know that as a parent and partner of our school, you do have rights. As a Title I federally funded school, it is our responsibility to provide you with a list of parental rights. Some of your rights are listed below. Please remember that we are here to help and assist your child to succeed! We are also here for you.

- You have the right to know and be notified in writing if your child's school is identified as unsafe.
- You have the right to know and receive written notification if your child becomes a victim of a violent crime at school. They may have the right to transfer to another school.
- You may request information about the qualifications of teachers and paraprofessionals who instruct their child.
- You have the right to request your child's name, address and telephone number not be released to a military recruiter without prior written consent.
- You have the right to receive timely notice that your child is assigned to or taught for four or more consecutive weeks by a teacher who is not highly qualified.
- You have the right to know that your child works with a paraprofessional under the direct supervision of a classroom teacher.
- You have the right to know the academic status of the school and any data available. Please visit the state website to view all updated school data at <https://www.tn.gov/education/reportcard/>
