We are writing to inform you that Overton High School was identified for ATSI as required by ESSA and the U.S. Department of Education during the 2017-18 school year; and will therefore maintain that designation during the 2021-22 school year.

Our school is working hard with the district and the Tennessee Department of Education to increase student performance by continuing to offer WIDA-specific prep in all ESL and ELD classes; expanding our ESL push-in support services for mathematics, science and ELA; adding additional ESL faculty to serve our growing EL student population; continuing to employ a full-time Bilingual Mentor to offer on-demand Spanish translation services as well as family and community support; offering a variety of print and technological resources for EL students; and offering targeted professional learning experiences for teachers to support EL students.
