CAPA Art & Creative Writing Students Success

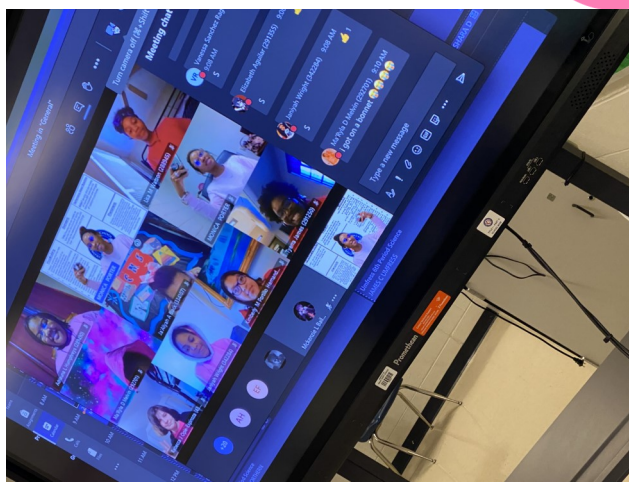

Pink Out Day

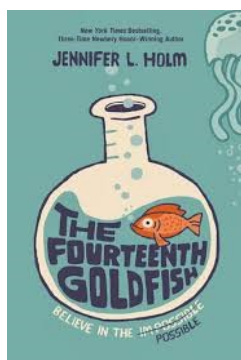
October was breast cancer awareness month. **Breast Cancer Awareness Month** is a yearly campaign to educate people about the importance of early screening, testing, and more.

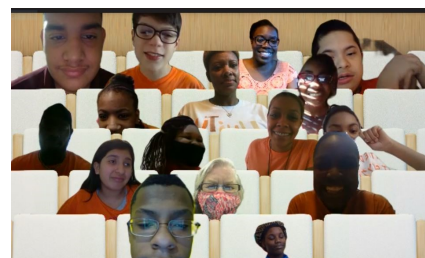
The Virtual Book Fair is Coming!
