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Dear Parents,

Hickory Ridge Elementary Family would like to provide our scholars with the opportunity to build their sense of fluency during this pandemic. We are providing the Fry Word List, for scholars to practice daily. This list consists of the most commonly used words in the English-language that must be easily recognized in order to achieve reading fluency. Once a child knows this list of words, it makes reading much easier, because the child can then focus his/her attention on the remaining, more complicated words in the text. Learning all 1,000 words in the Fry list would equip a child to read about 90% of the words in a typical book, newspaper, or website.

Being that these words and math facts are so vital in the success of our scholars, Hickory Ridge will be launching a sight word challenge (Grades K-5), an addition math facts challenge (Grades K-2), and multiplication facts challenge (Grades 3-5). We want to give students a head start on learning and to give them a leg up on prizes to be won once school starts! Use some of your time at home this summer to work with your scholars on reading their sight words with accuracy and computing their math facts with accuracy. Every week this summer, be sure to work with your scholars. We cannot wait to quiz and reward our scholars for all their hard work!!!
