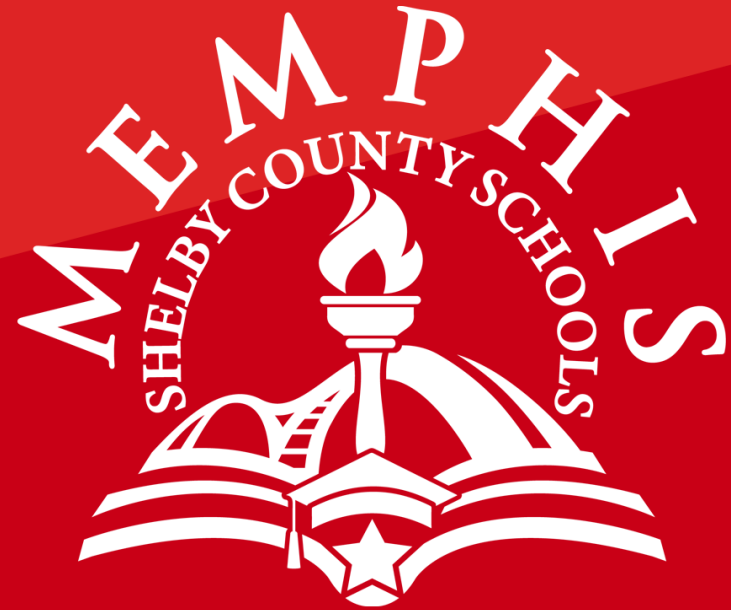
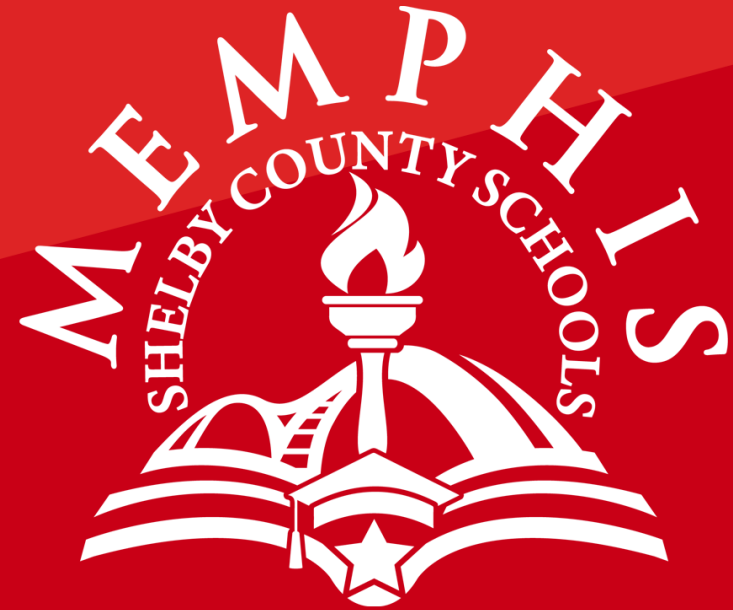

iReady Data

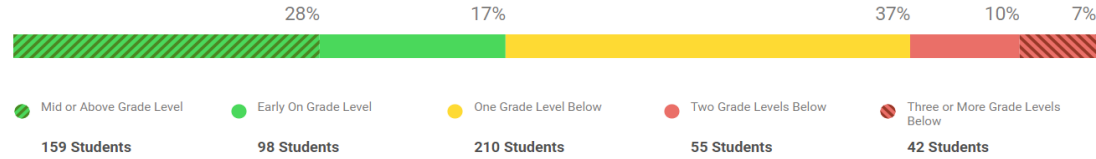


- iReady is a computer-adaptive test (CAT).
- Computer-adaptive tests continually adjust the difficulty of each test by determining each question based on the previous response.
- The iReady assessment is used as a diagnostic screening tool to identify students who may need additional academic support and monitor student growth.
- iReady is a K-8 intervention that provide specific tools and lessons to support areas the individual student is struggling.
- In addition, iReady can help teachers determine appropriate instructional areas and skills to focus on during small group intervention instruction.

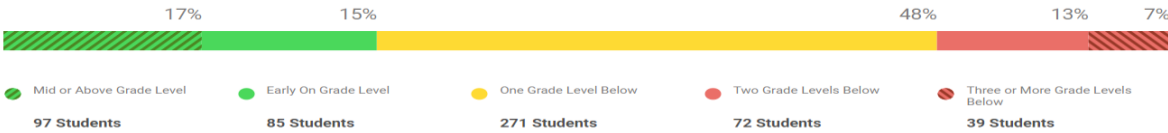

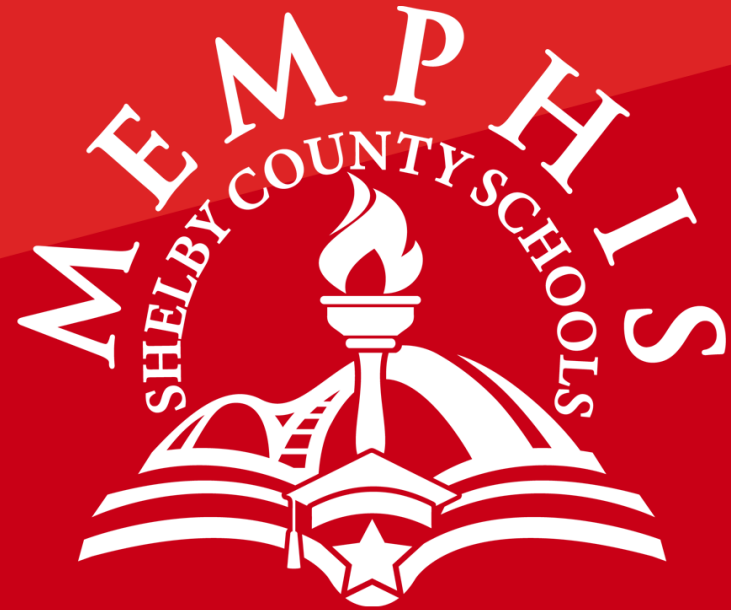

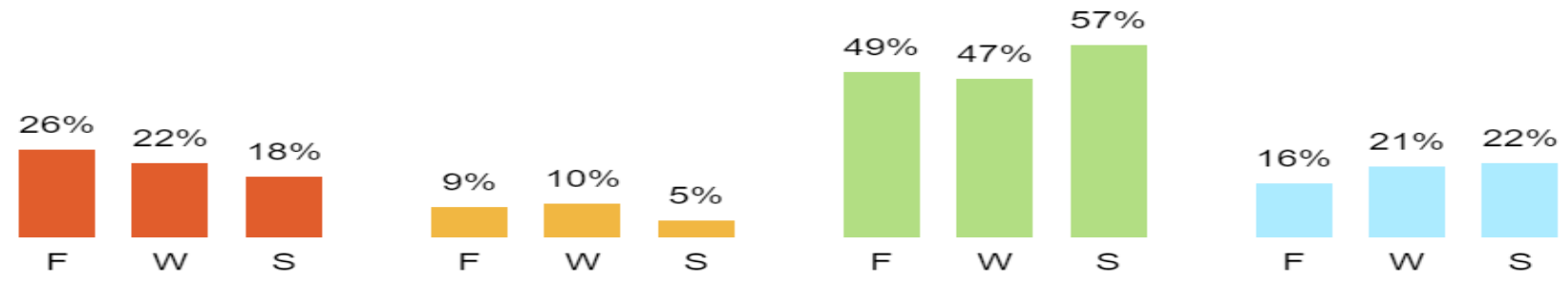
- Grades K-8 will participate in skill-based reading and math screener assessments.
- Illuminate/FastBridge is the newly selected RTI² assessment platform for students in grades K-8 and will replace easyCBM in the 2021-2022 school year.
- Illuminate Education can be used in both special education and regular education in order to meet the state guidelines related to effective implementation of RTI².
- Illuminate Education provides in-depth information on students' strengths and areas of need for specific skills in reading and math.
- The goal of the process is to monitor student progress as the student receives intervention with the expectation that the intervention will result in the student achieving at high levels of learning while closing the achievement gap among same-age peers.

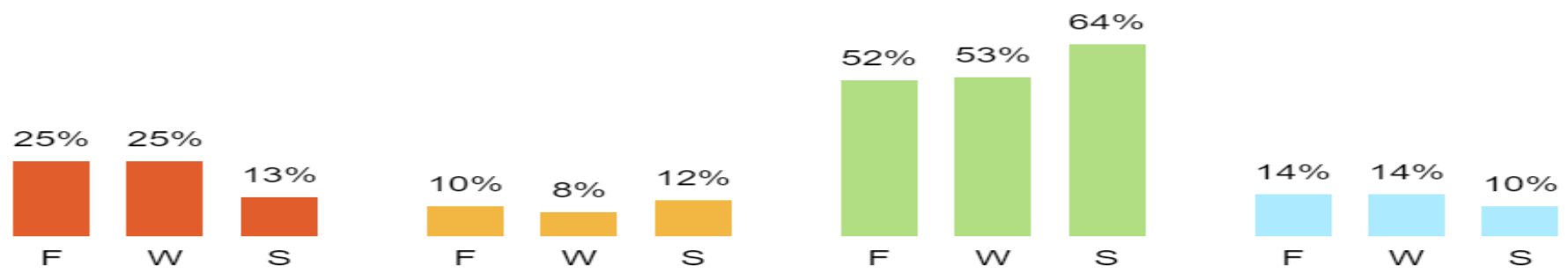

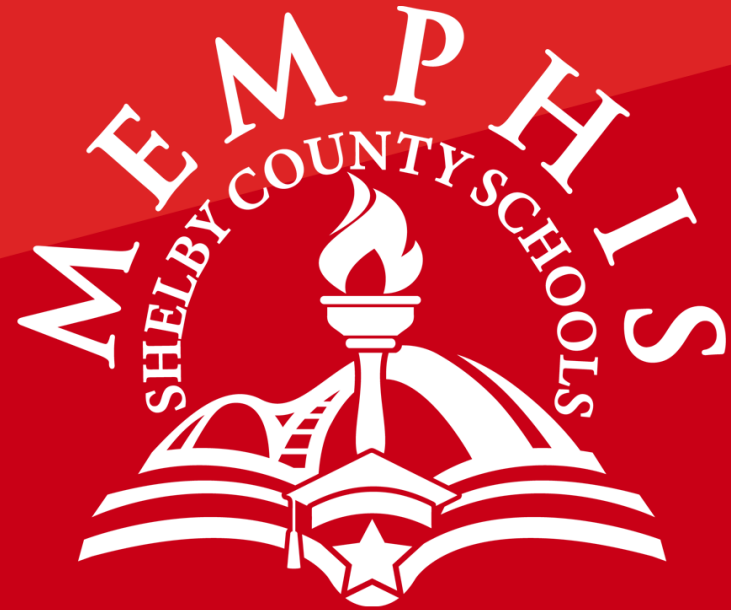

3rd Grade Commitment (3GC)



- Memphis-Shelby County Schools identifies student achievement as its highest priority. The Shelby County School Board voted to revise. Policy 5013 Promotion and Retention.
- The revision ensures we hold district and school leaders, teachers, and all stakeholders accountable towards ensuring SCS students have the necessary reading skills to be successful before they reach the third grade.
- Third grade has been identified as the year that students are no longer “learning to read” but they begin “reading to learn.” If students are not reading on grade level by the time they reach the third grade, half of the curriculum for the remainder of their school years will be beyond their understanding.
- Students who meet 8 of the 12 Criteria for Success at the conclusion of the second grade, will be eligible for promotion to the third grade.
- The **3rd Grade Commitment** is a collaborative effort between schools, parents and community to help SCS students reach reading readiness before the third grade.
