#### A few important reminders for October:

For the safety and security of all, respect GES arrival and dismissal procedures. Do not ever park in the Fire Lane/circle drive in front of the school. Do not drive above 15 mph on Cross Country during arrival and dismissal. Do not drive into the Faculty Parking Lot. Do not make u-turns in front of vehicles or pull around them in car line. If you are late to school, drive to the Visitor Lot via Farm Park, park your vehicle, and walk across the front of the school to enter the main doors. Campus visitors are screened before entry to the building regarding the purpose for visiting. Expect to be denied entry if your arrival is not expected and understand our acting in the best interest of all.

Attendance every day, all day, increases your child's chance for success in school. It is the expectation that GES students have a 96% attendance rate or better! It is the state, district and GES expectation that students have fewer than 10 attendance events a year including tardies, early checkouts, absences and/or late pick-ups. In addition, it is expected that students respect themselves, their peers, all staff, and our school property. It is our goal that student behavior is TOP NOTCH at all times and our wish that students have NO discipline infractions! Help us help you and your child by having high, consistent expectations, TOGETHER!
