

G9 Road to 22 Reflection Survey Shelby County Schools

Task/Survey Student Instructions

To earn a regular high school diploma, students must meet minimum standards established by the State Board of Education (i.e., have a satisfactory of attendance and discipline, for students enrolled in a Tennessee public school during their eleventh (11th) grade year take either the ACT or SAT, pass the United States civics test with a 70, or higher) and earn the following 22 units of credit.

To ensure you are on track for earning the required 22 units of credit for high school graduation, it is important to review your course history and plan your next steps with your family and counselor. To see if you are on-track for meeting your graduation requirements, let's review your course history in Naviance.

IMPORTANT NOTE: By the time you finish your 9th grade year, you should have earned: 5 units of credit and passed English I.

Survey Questions:

- 1. How many credits are in your plan? (select from range of numbers: 0-5, 6-11, 12-16, 17-22+)
- 2. What is the status for your English I (green-passed, yellow-in-progress, red-did not pass, white/blank- not in plan)? (drop down: passed, did not pass, course in progress, not taken yet, course not in my plan)
- 3. Are you on track or off-track in meeting your 9th grade units of credit requirements (9th grade requirements: 5 or more credits AND passed English I)? (on-track: I have or anticipate having completed the 9th grade requirements, off-track: I am missing or anticipate not having all 9th grade completed requirements) (drop down box of on-track and off-track)
- 4. If you are off-track in meeting your requirements, what is your immediate next step to help get you on track? (open box)
