Upon completion and submission of the online application, the PDF of the completed application will be emailed to your applicant. Your applicant should print the application, sign the PDF of the application, and attach the signed PDF into the online application. Also, the signed recommendation letter, should be attached within the application for final submission. (Please <u>ensure faculty</u> <u>members recommend only one student</u>, to apply for this laudable scholarship. Applicants with duplicate referring individuals will be disqualified.)

School counselors must send the applicant's official transcript, including the school seal, to <u>macscholarship1@gmail.com</u> by Tuesday, March 9, 2021. ALL documentation <u>MUST BE</u> <u>SUBMITTED</u> by Tuesday, March 9, 2021.
