



At Mississippi State, believing in your potential and investing in your future is more than an idea. It's something we champion. Every student and circumstance is different, and our Student Financial Aid office and the Office of Admissions and Scholarships are here to help turn your dreams of a college education into a reality. Need help paying for college? There are two main forms of assistance: scholarships and financial aid.

Financial Aid sfa.

Federal aid can come in the form of grants, loans and even part-time employment for students who qualify. You must file a FAFSA-that's the Free Application for Federal Student Aid-to be eligible. Then consult with our office and your own support system to understand your options.

How to Apply for Financial Aid

First, submit the FAFSA. It goes live on October 1 at studentaid.gov.

Use the IRS Data Retrieval Tool and include Mississippi State University's federal code: **002423**.

Financial aid is awarded through grants, loans and work-study positions. Grants for Mississippi residents may be found at **msfinancialaid.org**.


