Frequently Asked Questions...

Who can transfer into an Optional program?

Qualified students can transfer into an Optional Program when the applicants meet all the entrance requirements of the school's Optional Program and space is available.

How do I apply online?

The Optional Schools Application Process is completely online for new students. Parents/legal guardians can easily complete and submit an online application from any personal computer, tablet or smartphone (with Internet access) that supports online forms.

- The online application portal will be accessible on the SCS website, www.scsk12.org
- Beginning at 10 a.m. on Tuesday, January 26, 2021
- A valid email address is required in order to submit the application online
- Current SCS students are encouraged to use their PowerSchool student number (also same as lunch number). For non-SCS students, a social security number is requested.
- You will receive an email confirmation with the date and time of your application submission.

What documents are needed in order to apply for an Optional transfer?

If the applicant is a current SCS student, SCS already has the required documents on file. Once a current SCS student's online application is submitted, no further action is needed to finalize the application.
