Founded in 1989 by Joseph "Pitt" Hyde, Memphis Challenge coaches high-achieving students of color through leadership and professional development. Our program serves high school students in grades 9-12 from public, private, independent, charter, and parochial schools across the county. Over the course of 30 years, we have impacted 1,500 youth and young adults. 97% of our Challengers have graduated from top colleges, and more than 830 are now living and working in Memphis.

Our goal is to fulfill the promise of the Memphis Challenge: ensure the region's most talented students bring their education, expertise, and connections back to Memphis.
