




Water Features


An ocean is a large body of water that takes up most of our planet! There are four oceans in the world. The closest one to us here is the Atlantic Ocean.

A peninsula is a piece of land that is part of a mainland and is mostly surrounded by water. You may know Florida as a state but did you know that it is also a peninsula?


