Video Requirements:

- Hair is pulled back out of face
- Small stud earrings ONLY (Please do not wear rings, necklaces, bracelets etc.)
- A white tank or t shirt
- Black shorts
- Tennis shoes
- Be sure to introduce yourself stating your name (first and last), and the grade you're going to
- Be creative/Show spirit
- Have fun

Physicals are Mandatory!! I advise you to go to your primary care physician to get your sports physical. Physicals must be on file and up to date in order to actively participate once the season has started.

Once the squad has been selected more information will be sent out regarding the parent meeting, cost, practices, code of conduct and much more. I can share that we will be keeping the uniform from last season and that practices will initially be via zoom until further notice.
