### **What is the Bolton AgriSTEM program?**

The Bolton AgriSTEM program is a new initiative apart of the Shelby County School Reimagining 901 plan. AgriSTEM at Bolton High will equip students with the tools and strategies that help them think critically and reason logically within tomorrow's interconnected world with a focus on agriculture and food production.

### **When will the AgriSTEM program take effect at Bolton High School?**

Bolton's transformation is currently underway. Bolton has already increased Dual Enrollment opportunities, partnerships are forming to provide students with live animals, and renovations have begun for numerous classes. By Spring 2022, Bolton is expected to have a newly renovated Culinary Arts kitchen, Automotive Shop, Construction classroom, and barn full of animals.

### **How will this program affect instruction and curriculum?**

Students will take part in STEM-focused curriculum with an integrated use of technology, outside of the classroom learning opportunities, early college-level coursework, STEM teaching staff, innovative school culture, and an updated learning experience centered around AgriSTEM.
