Family Engagement Plan

Federal law requires schools that receive Title I funding to create a Family Engagement Plan to encourage parents and family members to get involved in their children's education.

Treadwell International Community School encourages ongoing parent involvement in our educational process. We have jointly developed with our parents a written Family Engagement Plan. Our School Level Family Engagement Plan has set expectations for parent involvement. We believe that all children have the right to a high-quality education.

To ensure that our parents are involved in the development and implementation of the school's program, Treadwell International Community School will encourage parents to do the following:

- **serve** in the decision-making process by participating in the Site-Based Leadership Committee and the PTO.
- **Attend** team-level meetings, parent conferences, programs, and PTO meetings.
- **Participation of Volunteers** in academic, extracurricular and co-curricular activities.
- Jointly develop a pact between the school and the parents.
- **Involve** parents in the planning and development of the Tennessee School Improvement Plan.

Administrators, faculty, and staff will provide a strategic plan and implement the requirements of Title I in accordance with the guidelines set forth in the law, including the following:

- **Convene** annual meetings at flexible times where all parents are invited. Meetings will be held in the morning and evening.
- **Provide** parents with timely information about Title I requirements, our school's participation in Title I, and parental participation rights in the school.
- **Allow parents to** observe school programs and visit classrooms
- **Schedule** a flexible number of meetings to inform parents about student progress
- **Provide** a description and explanation of each child's curriculum, academic assessments, and proficiency level.
- **Encourage** parents and students to join our local TDF and attend Title I/Career Development Meetings provided during flexible hours.

- **Encourage parents** to attend all open and family night events that address our students' curriculum, assessments, and performance levels

- **Involve** parents in an organized, continuous and timely manner, in the planning, review and improvement of programs for parent participation and the Family Participation Plan at the School Level.

To ensure that our parents are involved in the development and implementation of the school's program, we will do the following:

- **Provide** opportunities for regular parent meetings to keep parents informed about school programs, activities, and progress, as well as accept feedback from parents.

- **Provide** alternative means of communication to provide information through our TMS newsletter, school calendar, brochure, website, etc.

- **Parent** and Teacher Behavior Conferences so that parents have the opportunity to chart their child's academic progress and discuss any issues with teachers.
