Summer Learning Academy FAQ

1. What is the purpose of the Summer Learning Academy?

Summer Learning Academy provides five weeks of additional reading and math instruction as well as intervention and physical activity and two weeks of ACT Prep for high school students. The academy is designed to support student's academic needs and provide additional learning opportunities for students that will be in first-twelfth grade for the 2022-2023 school year.

2. What is the STREAM mini-camp?

The STREAM mini-camp will take place during the 8:00-3:00 or 9:00-4:00 instructional day. The STREAM course provides instruction and engagement through programming in which students participate in real-world experiences and problem-solving across several content areas.

- 3. What are the dates and times for Summer Learning Academy? Elementary and Middle School: June 13-July 15 (see times below) High School: June 13-June 24 9:00 a.m.-12:00 p.m.
- 4. Will Summer Learning Academy be in-person or virtual? The Tennessee Learning Loss Remediation and Student Acceleration Act requires that all academies be in-person.

- Will all students receive transportation? Only students that traditionally receive transportation based on the district's criteria will receive transportation.
- 7. Will all schools operate a Summer Learning Academy? All schools will not operate a Summer Learning Academy. Summer Learning Academy locations will be clustered based on proximity and capacity. Elementary and Middle school students will be assigned to SLA sites based on the current school they attend. High school students can select to attend either Douglass or Overton.
- 8. Will before and after care be offered? Before and after care will be offered. Services will be contracted through an outside vendor.

- 10. Do students have to wear uniforms? No, students do not have to wear uniforms.

- 11. Do students need to bring their devices. Yes, students need to bring devices daily.
