Testing Protocols

- Students should arrive on time, no later than 8:15 am during EOC and ASVAB testing.
- AP testing students should arrive at the designated time listed on the calendar above.
- All students will have their temperatures scanned upon entering
- Uniforms are not mandatory; however, appropriate attire is. No revealing or inappropriate clothing.
- Masks must be worn at all times while in the building, except when eating or drinking.
- Testing rooms have been adjusted to ensure social distancing and small teacherstudent ratios.
- During EOC testing, students will be allowed to leave after testing. Students who remain will be included in the Bulldog matinees. We will have a movie projected in the auditorium, while students are seated socially distant, waiting for their ride.
- Lunch will be available each day of testing. As weather permits, students may enjoy lunch outside.







What if my student doesn't have a test on a specific day, what do they do?

- Non-tested subjects will have asynchronous assignments that extend throughout the work.
 - No late work, student must check their TEAMS daily, as they would in school.
- Tested subjects (EOC and AP)
 - Students will have a schedule, which we will communicate of LIVE sessions, look for calendar invites starting this week
 - During sessions, students will engage in review and prep for their tests. Attendance will be taken and assignments will be assessed.

• DE Courses

- Teachers of DE courses will meet with their classes in real-time.
- Attendance will be taken

• Additional Sessions - ACT Prep

 Specific juniors and sophomores will be pulled for LIVE ACT prep sessions. Families will be notified and students must attend, attendance will be taken.


Serving our community
