Middle College has outscored opponents 184-8 in 4 games

Running back Moore continues to fuel offense

Middle College was missing four starters, including its quarterback Thursday night. But that didn't stop the Bulldogs from picking up a 60-0 win over Westwood.

Running back Antonyous Moore scored four touchdowns to help Middle College (4-0) put the game away early. My strength is my speed. I'm chucky, so they can't touch me," Moore said. "And I have a great line. They do

what they're supposed to do and I just follow them."

Moore has been starting for Middle College since his sophomore year. Middle College missed last season as Shelby County Schools opted not to play fall sports due to COVID-19, but Moore has hit the ground running in his senior season.

"He's come back with a vengeance in his senior season. He's one of the leaders in the city as far as yards per carry and I think he had about four carries today with four touchdowns," coach Lennorris Staples said. "Every time he touches the ball he wants to take it to the house. He's a threat every time, whether he's catching it, running it, or even sometimes we put him at quarterback. He's special all-around."

Moore plays four sports at Middle College; football, basketball, baseball and track. He said football is No. 1.

Moore's dad, Anthony Keith Moore, is the athletic director at Hamilton. He said he developed his love for the game from a young age playing with his dad.

"We go to football games together, and sometimes we take it to the field working on my routes and my 40 time and all that. I knew that I loved the game as soon as I started playing. I started out as a receiver, but switched

to running back when I got to college."

Middle College has outscored opponents 184-8 this season, averaging 46 points per game. The defense has posted shutouts in four games.

"Most of my backs are great, and they love to run," Moore said. "So we love to feed them. It's like three-card monte. You don't know who is getting the ball. I have three great backs that can catch the ball, and it's unpredictable who will have the great play and throw the ball and pick their poison."
