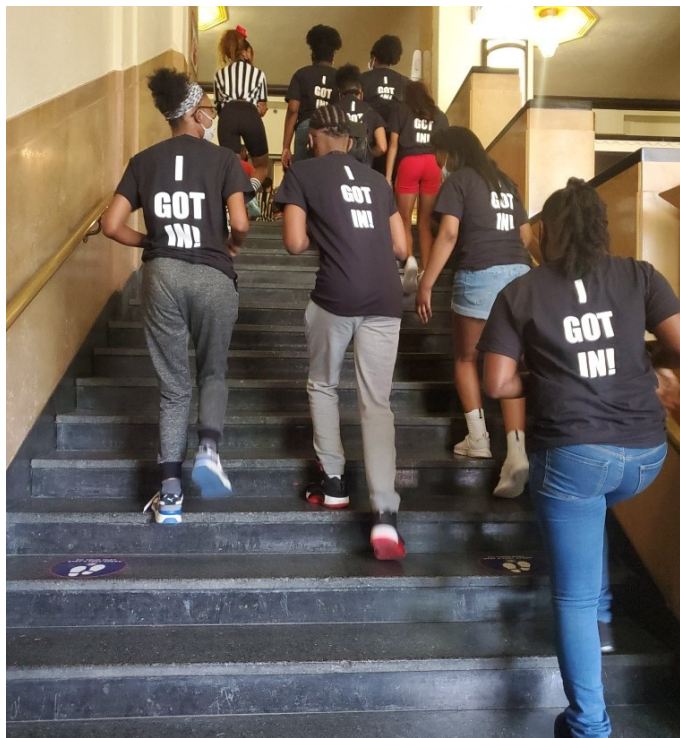

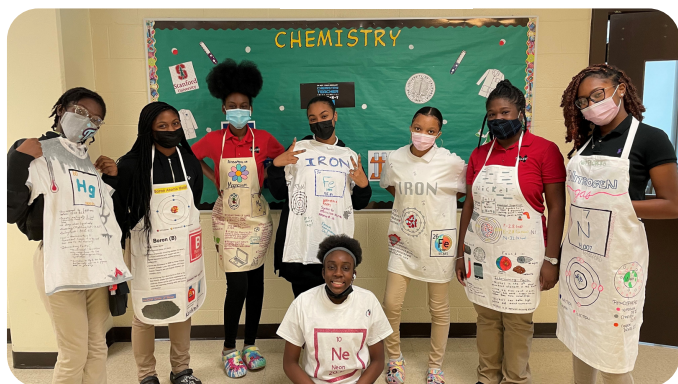
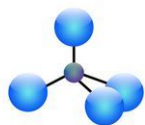

FINALISTS ANNOUNCED!!!!!!

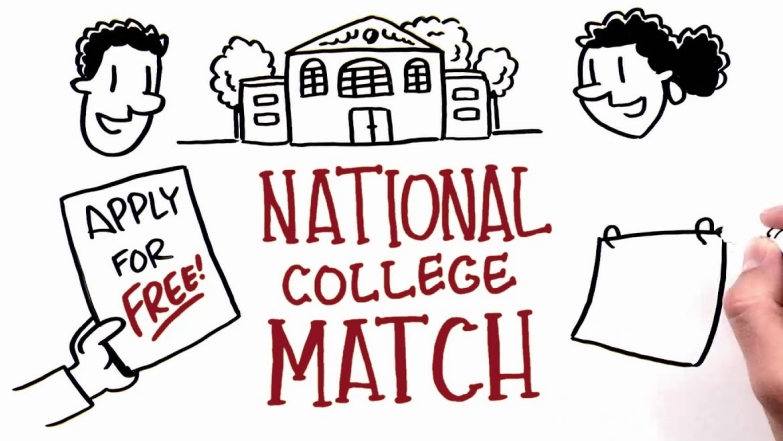

Academic Profile

- Average GPA: 3.91
- Class rank: 87% from the top 10%
- Scored above 1260 on the SAT or 27 on the ACT (if reported): 80%

The MCHS Football team are your Region 1A Champions!!!!

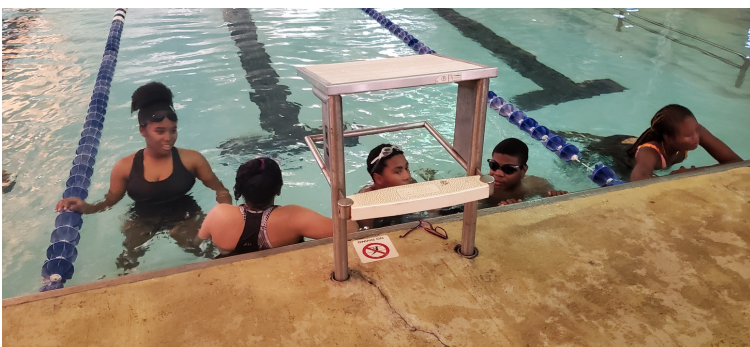

Parents, please be aware:
