77 of our 9th and 10th grade students took the October 23rd ACT. Over

30% of them scored a 21 composite or higher! We are well on our way for 100% of our students to have Ready Graduate status by graduation. Even those who didn't meet their score goals, worked hard and several improved their scores. Let's keep working! The last test of the year is December 11th.

Reminder: All MCHS students are required to take the ACT each year and rising juniors and seniors should achieve a composite of 19 or higher to take full advantage of course offerings and programs.

# Parents, please be aware:



- Students **MUST** be present and on time daily. We are a choice school, where transfers may be rescinded for several reasons which include:
  - 10 or more unexcused absences, tardies, late arrivals, or early dismissals.
- When there are no special occasions, which are announced, regular uniform MUST be worn.
- The **ONLY** MCHS approved hoodie during the week is the luminary hoodie. Seniors are allowed to wear their senior hoodies on Fridays **ONLY**.
- Our uniform policy can be accessed in the student handbook. Please refer to it for questions/concerns.
- As students gain the privilege to dress "college smart" by becoming Ready Graduate status, they must receive their Ready Graduate band to dress out.
- Cell phones are not allowed OUT in the classroom, it disrupts the learning environment. Students will receive infractions and possibly lose privileges if they continue this practice.
