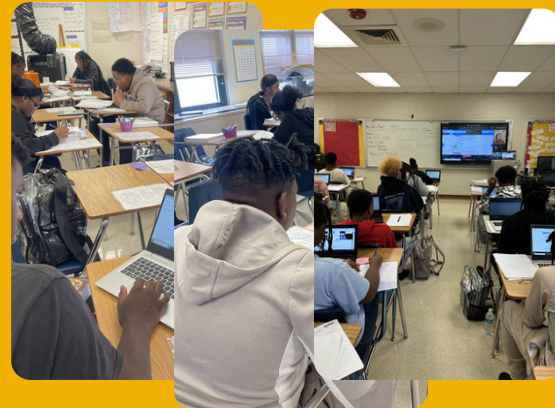


Great things are happening at Mitchell High School!!!!

"English Language Arts"

In 11th Grade English, students are reading historical nonfiction documents to explore the essential question, "What is the meaning of freedom?" In the Declaration of Independence, Thomas Jefferson explains that we have certain unalienable rights that the British were not acknowledging. Students have analyzed the Preamble to the Constitution and Bill of Rights which gives a more detailed description of citizens' individual rights and places limitations to the power the government has.

In 9th grade English, students are diving into identifying themes in literature! Students spent last week reading "The Writing on the Wall" which focused on immigration and poetry that was written on the walls of an immigration center in San Francisco. Students took their first shot at identifying theme using this text and used ACE format to write about it!

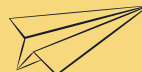
