Frequently Asked Questions for Students and Families

*Will there be a Bolton High School Graduation Ceremony this year? Given the current situation surrounding the COVID-19 pandemic, and guidance from our local and state health officials, we will not be able to hold our traditional graduation ceremony on May 16, 2020 as scheduled. Update: SCS District will be celebrating our Seniors in 3 Phases. Phase 1: A Senior Website will be launched by May 18, 2020. Phase 2: Drive Through Senior Salute during the week of June 8th. Phase 3: Traditional Graduation Ceremony July 13- July 26 (tentative) A back up plan for Virtual Graduation Ceremony has been devised, but the District has every intention on having a traditional ceremony.

*Will Bolton High School Seniors receive their Cap and Gown? Yes. Students will be able to pick up the cap and gown in May. A specific time for pick up will be communicated via robo messaging, social media and posted on the Bolton Website.

*Can I pay my Senior Fees now? Yes. If you have not paid your Senior fees, email Ms. Pirtle at <u>pirtledj@scsk12.org</u>. You will receive a response with the amount and time available to make payment.

accordance with the directions of Shelby County Schools, Bolton High School will be prepared to refund a portion of the Senior fees and will provide additional refund-related information to students. More information about Spring sport fees that were collected by the school will be announced. Schools will be reaching out to affected students and families directly regarding refunds.

*Will my child be able to pick-up personal and school-related items? Refunds must be picked up by a parent/guardian, unless other arrangements are made with Principal Gnintedem. Parents will be contacted if their students are receiving a refund. Instructions and a specific day and time will be communicated.

*When can I pick-up/drop off items? Information on when you can pickup/drop-off other items such as caps and gowns, yearbooks, spring pictures, library books, textbooks, instruments, etc. will be provided.

*How will students receive their final grades? How will I know if my child passed their grade level? Final report cards will be mailed on May 18-May 22, 2020. More details will be shared when the report cards have posted.

*Do I have to register for the 2020-2021 school year? Yes. All students must register for the 2020-2021 school year. Registration is now open in the parent portal. If you need support, please contact <u>SCShelp@scsk12.org</u>.

*How can I complete course selections for next year? Grade level counselors will be contacting students starting on or before May 1, 2020.

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
