## 20-21 School Year Survey – Deadline Saturday, July 18, 2020

<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Temperature checks for all students and staff will take place before entering the building.</li> <li>• All students and staff will wear masks/face guards and PPE during the school day.</li> <li>• Sanitizing stations will be placed in or outside of each classroom.</li> <li>• Transitions will be limited.</li> <li>• Breakfast and Lunch will be held in the classroom.</li> <li>• Individual supplies will be used (no sharing).</li> <li>• Floor signs will indicate where students need to stand.</li> <li>• Arrival/dismissal procedures will be altered to prevent large student grouping.</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Regular School Day 9:15 – 4:15</li> <li>• Students are responsible for submitting assignments on time as specified by the teacher</li> <li>• Grades and student feedback will be weekly</li> <li>• Homework will be assigned daily or weekly</li> <li>• Students will have access to virtual content as necessary (i.e. recorded lessons, resources, etc.)</li> </ul>

<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Devices provided by SCS for all students with expectations for usage &amp; care.</li> <li>• Attendance to all assigned virtual classes is <b>mandatory</b></li> <li>• Virtual assignments will be submitted weekly</li> <li>• Parents will need to assist students with logging in (primary students may need more assistance)</li> <li>• Kate Bond Elementary has a Technology Support Team to assist parents with technology challenges.</li> </ul> <p style="text-align: center;"><b>RESPOND TODAY!!!!</b></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• KBE teachers will provide Virtual Instruction for KBE children on Microsoft TEAMS and Clever: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>⇒ ELA – 2 hours (Teacher Led Instruction) 45 min (30 min reflective writing, 15 min reading daily)</li> <li>⇒ Math - 1 hour</li> <li>⇒ Science - 30- Min (M/W/F)</li> <li>⇒ Social Studies - 30 min. (T/Th)</li> <li>⇒ Intervention - 45 min * I Ready</li> <li>⇒ Support Classes - 30 min/day</li> </ul> </li> <li>• Students will receive feedback from the teacher.</li> <li>• Virtual teachers will hold weekly office hours to support students</li> <li>• SPED instruction will depend on IEP to determine time on task and modifications, related services, and other supports.</li> </ul>
