"Facts about _____" Research paper and Rough Draft due—Friday, September 29, 2023 for grades 2nd & 5th only.

Final Draft for grades 2nd & 5th Due- Thursday, October 5, 2023.

International Studies project with writing portion is due for grades KK, 1st, 3rd, and 4th on Thursday, October 5th.

The topic is Geography, and each project MUST be accompanied with a writing portion to receive the total points for grade. Projects will count for 3 grades (ELA for Writing, Social Studies for Project and Assessment).
