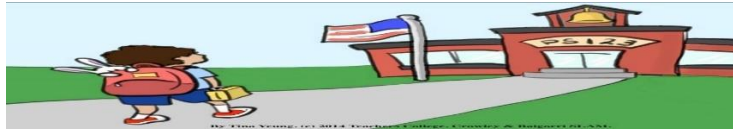

OPEN HOUSE/TITLE ONE MEETING

PEABODY CLUBS

As a Responsive Classroom school, Peabody believes in building strong students academically and socially. Therefore, Peabody teachers host clubs from October-April each school year to engage our students socially. **Parents will be able to sign-up for Peabody Clubs during OPEN HOUSE. Remember, there are limited spaces per Club.** Please come to Open House to sign-up to ensure your child a space when applications are released.

TUTORING OPPORTUNITY

Peabody will offer After School Tutoring to students in grades K-5 on Mondays and Tuesdays from 3:30-4:50 P.M.

If you would like your child to be a part of the tutoring program, you must apply through Power School. Tutoring is based on students' academic performance from the previous school year. For students in grades 1st and 2nd, we will use student's spring iReady scores to determine their eligibility. For students in grades 3rd through 5th, students' TCAP results will be used to determine their eligibility for tutoring.

Please check your email for the attached steps to support you with completing the tutoring application through PowerSchool.

Tutoring Offer Letters will be emailed on Friday, September 1, 2023. Students who are placed on the tutoring wait list will be notified as well.

For students in Grade 4, if you received a letter and phone call last week, you will not have to apply again. Your child is automatically enrolled in tutoring based on the 4th Grade Literacy Law.

Spaces are limited, and the state's student to teacher ratio for tutoring is 1:5 or 1:8, depending on the grade level. Here are the available spaces below.
