### **PEABODY SCHOOL BUS REVISION**

Parents, starting tomorrow- Tuesday, September 26<sup>th</sup>, there will only be (1) MSCS School Bus that will transport Peabody students from Peabody to Middle College High School. The bus will arrive at Peabody Elementary @ 7:40 A.M. each morning and will not return for another pick-up. If your child rides the Neighborhood MSCS Bus, their schedule will remain the same.

Again, there will only be one bus picking up (7:40 a.m.) and dropping off (3:15 p.m.) students at Peabody Elementary now.
