INTERNATIONAL STUDIES PORJECTS



It's time for our Quarter One projects! Your child will complete research about the geography of the country they're studying this year; they will show their learning by creating a 3D map of their country. Each project must be accompanied by a writing section. This project is due on **Friday, September 23, 2022 for grades 1st-5th**. Kindergarten projects will be due on **Friday, September 30, 2022. Projects count for (2) grades- writing and Social Studies Project. Points will be deducted after the due date.** Project descriptions were sent home last week in your child's Tuesday folder.

PARENT REMINDERS

Please send your child to school with a uniform jacket/sweater daily. We have a new HVAC system and it is very cold in the classrooms. Just ensure the jacket/sweater is within Dress Code guidelines:

Light jackets, sweatshirts, cardigans, sweaters, or vests may be worn; however, they must be white, light blue, Peabody blue, navy, black, or gray- WITHOUT PRINTS OR LOGOS. Heavy coats may not be worn during the school day. No denim material may be worn. T-shirts worn underneath a shirt should be white. Peabody club or spirit T-shirts (Purchased from PTA, After School care, or Peabody) can be worn on Friday with uniform bottoms.
