FIELD TRIP PAYMENTS ARE CASHLESS NOW

We have transitioned over to cashless payments for field trips. We are no longer accepting cash for students to attend field trips. At the bottom of this letter, you will find a QR code that will link you to the Memphis-Shelby County School's Cashless System. Use the steps below to complete a transaction for your child's field trip. Again, all field trips are now paid for through the cashless system online. Peabody no longer accepts cash for field trip payments.

1. Create an account online and link the account to your child's PowerSchool information.
2. Filter to the appropriate field trip for your child's grade.
3. Pay the amount for the field trip.
4. Screenshot the confirmation page and send this information to your child's teacher.
