FAQs

OPERATIONAL QUESTIONS

1. Will temperatures be taken every day? Even in the rain?

Yes. Temperature checks will occur every day before adults and/or students enter the building.

2. When will the supply lists for each grade be available?

Supply lists for both virtual and in-person options will be posted on the website soon. Students will not be able to share items while at school.

3. Will extracurricular activities and events be available?

No activities requiring large groups will be available for the Fall Semester.

4. Will parents be able to walk in?

Parents will not be able to enter the building and walk the hall in the morning or afternoon. Only 2 parents/visitors will be allowed in the office at a time. We ask other parents to wait patiently outside in the order you arrive at the school.

5. Will parents be able to walk their child to their classroom?

No, parents will be asked to drop off their child at the point of entry for their grade. A map will be provided on the website soon.

6. Where will students eat?

All students will eat breakfast and lunch in their classroom.

7. Will parents be able to change their decision after July 24th for Virtual or In-school?

No information from the district has been provided at this time. Choose what is best for your family during the first semester.

8. Will Kindergarten have staggered entry?

Yes. More information will be provided to the parents after registration closer to the start of the school year.

VIRTUAL LEARNING

1. Does my child have to sit in front of a computer for 7-8 hours?

No. Classroom schedules will allot times for students to listen to instruction from the teacher and work independently away from the computer if and when needed.

2. What are the sizes of the virtual classroom?

Class sizes will be determined by virtual and in-school enrollment numbers.

3. Will virtual students have the workbooks and textbooks they need?

Germanshire will allot times for virtual students to pick up needed text/workbooks from school.

4. What curriculum will be used for virtual learning and in-school learning?

The same curriculum will be used for both virtual and in-school students.

5. What will a virtual school day look like?

The virtual school day will be structured like an in-person school day as it relates to classes (ELA, Math, Music, PE, Science, etc. - whole class and small group).

IN-SCHOOL LEARNING

1. Are students required to wear face masks?

All students are required to wear a face mask. We ask parents to practice wearing face masks with students at home to help them become more acclimated.

2. What will YCARE look like?

YCARE will be collaborating with Germanshire on new procedures and location. Updates will be coming soon.

3. What will support classes look like?

Support teachers (STEAM, Art, Music, PE, etc.) will provide lessons in students' homeroom classes. Students will not transition to classes and will not share materials/items such as instruments, supplies, and/or materials needed for lessons.

4. What will be the class size?

Class sizes will be determined by the number of students that register for in-school learning.

5. How will students be socially distant in school?

Germanshire will use best practices in keeping students socially distant, such as:

- a. Students will be socially distant when traveling to the restroom in the hallways (6 ft apart with face masks).
- b. In classrooms, student desks and tables will be spaced apart from each other.
