


## WHERE IN THE WORLD IS THE U.S.A

Due: Friday, October 3, 2025

Kindergarten will study the USA this year, and one of the expectations is that they are able to locate the United States on a world map (K.14). Our first project is to make a replica of a globe or world map that clearly demonstrates knowledge of the location of the United States in relation to the rest of the world. Students will use their creative minds to highlight our country with red on your globe/map. Please work with your child to make a spectacular globe/map, but please make sure your child's work is evident.

Your child has brought home the basic outlines of the 7 continents that he/she will need to complete the project. How you will display the project:

1. extra large paper plate (DO NOT USE STYROFOAM)



Use the following steps to create the globe/world map:

- 1. Paint or color your base (plate, oval) completely blue.
- 2. Using the continent outlines, have your child color or paint each continent a different color. Do not use red for any of the continents; the United States will be shown with red
- 3. Use **red** paint, glitter, felt, puff paint, fun foam, markers, crayons, etc. to fill in and highlight the USA on the continent of North America. Don't forget to include Alaska and Hawaii.
- 4. Have your child label the United States by writing "U.S.A"
- 5. Cut out the continents on the dotted lines
- 6. Using a globe or world map as a reference, glue the continent outlines to the base in their appropriate locations.
- 7. Add a small item to locate Memphis, TN. You can use a tiny pom pom or something small to glue or attach to identify where in the USA that TN is found. You don't want to use anything too big because it will cover up the letters for "USA".
