

Whitehaven High School Family Engagement Plan



The high school encourages Whitehaven to involve parents in the educational process. We develop a family engagement plan written with our parents. The school-wide Family Engagement Plan has set expectations for parent involvement. We share a common goal: to help all children succeed every day. We will:

- 1. Convene annual meetings at flexible times where all parents are invited, informed of Title I requirements, Title I school participation, and parents' right to participate in school.
- 2. Provide, describe, and explain to parents each child's curriculum, academic assessment, and proficiency level, raising awareness of parents' right to know.
- 3. Provide timely information about programs with parent involvement.
- 4. Provide opportunities for regular parent meetings to keep them informed of Whitehaven activities and progress, as well as to solicit parent feedback.
- 5. Work with parents to develop a covenant between the school and parents.
- 6. Encourage parents to be involved in the decision-making process by participating in the Whitehaven Board of Directors and the Parent, Teacher, and Student Organization (PTSO).
- 7. Encourage parental involvement in school and extracurricular activities.
- 8. Engage parents, in an organized, ongoing, and timely manner, in the planning, review, and improvement of school-wide parent engagement programs and the family engagement plan.
- 9. Involve parents in the annual planning and development of the Tennessee School Improvement Plan.
- 10. Schedule a flexible number of meetings; Arrange parent conferences and mail hard copies of students' curriculum and report cards to inform parents of the student's academic progress.
- 11. Provide alternative means of communication to provide information (brochures, newsletters, school website, school messaging, social media).
- 12. Sponsor a variety of workshops so that parents have the opportunity to participate in the development of their educational programs.
