## Family Engagement Policy


TSTEM Academy @ East High School has jointly developed with parents a Family Engagement Plan. This plan has established the expectations for parental involvement.

- Provide parents with opportunities for regular meeting





## Parents' Right To Know

### **All parents have the right to request the following:**

- A teacher's professional qualifications, licensure, grades/certifications, waivers
- A teacher's baccalaureate and/or graduate degree, fields of endorsement, previous teaching experience.
- A paraprofessional's qualifications
- An annual notice of Students Education Records Privacy and Notice for disclosure of School Directory Information
- Their child's level of achievement in each of the Tennessee academic assessments
- Notification of right to transfer child to another school in the district if student becomes the victim of a violent crime or is assigned to an unsafe school.
- District Family Engagement Policy and School Family Engagement Plan
- Their right to public school choice, supplemental services, and more effective involvement in their child's school if the school is identified for school improvement.
- Timely notification that their child has been assigned to, or has been taught for four or more consecutive weeks, by a teacher who does not meet the definition of Highly Qualified.



### **2024-2025 School Improvement Plan**


#### **Four Goals for the 2024-2025 School Year**

1. By the Spring of 2025, East High School has a goal of improving the percentage of students scoring On-Track and Mastery on the TNReady exam in English I from 62.8% in 2023 to 70% in 2025 and a goal of improving the percentage of students scoring On-track and Mastery in English II from 83.8 in 2023 to 87% in the spring of 2025 on the TNReady exam for a combined scored of 78.5% by the spring of 2025
2. By Spring 2025, East High School has a goal of improving Algebra I scores to 45% of students scoring On-Track and Mastery, increasing Geometry scores to 30% and increasing Algebra II scores to 70%. These combined scores would bring the total number of math students scoring On-Track and Mastery to 48% in the Spring of 2025.
3. For the 2024-2025 school year, East High School has set a goal to increase the number of ready graduates to 100%, an increase of 5%.
4. East High School has set a goal to decrease the number of students chronically absent from school to 5% for the 2024-2025 school year, a reduction of 8%.

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
