

CORDOVA HIGH SCHOOL DRESS CODE POLICY

1. Pants must be worn at the waist and must be an appropriate size. All pants must be worn at a safe length. **JEANS WORN MUST NOT HAVE RIPS OR TEARS IN THEM AND MUST NOT BE FORM FITTING.**
2. Tightfitting clothing or leggings worn as pants (i.e. "Jeggings," "yoga pants") cannot be worn. Skin-tight outer materials such as spandex are prohibited.
3. Shirts, blouses, and dresses must completely cover the abdomen, back, shoulders and must have sleeves.
4. Shirts or tops must cover the waistband of pants, shorts, or skirts with no midriff visible. Low-cut blouses, shirts, extremely tight tops, tube tops, or any top that exposes cleavage are prohibited.
5. Shirts, blouses, and tops must be no longer than wrist-length.
6. Except for religious or medical purposes, head apparel (such as hoods, hats, etc.), may not be worn inside the school building.
7. Footwear is required and must be safe and appropriate for indoor and outdoor activity. Any student working in CHS shop class (automotive, HVAC, etc.) are not allowed to wear sandals/flip-flops for safety reasons. House slippers are not allowed.
8. Clothing and accessories such as backpacks, patches, jewelry, and notebooks must not display:
(1) racial or ethnic slurs/symbols, (2) gang affiliations, (3) vulgar, subversive, or sexually suggestive images, (4) promotion of products which students may not legally buy; such as alcohol, tobacco, and illegal drugs.
9. Skirts, dresses, and shorts must be no shorter than 4 inches above the knee.
10. Sleepwear, pajamas, and/or blankets cannot be worn or be carried in school.
11. Waist length sweaters, sweatshirts, and lightweight jackets (appropriately sized) can be worn inside school for warmth.
12. Prohibited items include:
(1) large, long and/or heavy chains, (2) studded or chained accessories, (3) sunglasses (except for health purposes), (4) sleepwear, (5) headphones/earbuds cannot be worn as part of dress during school hours.

Any student not attired in accordance with the CHS Dress Code Policy shall be subject to the following consequences:

- 1) First Violation: Students may do one of three things:
 - A. Students will correct the dress code violation or
 - B. Students will call home for a change of clothes
 - C. If the student cannot correct the dress code violation or call home for a change of clothes, the student will finish the remainder of the day in in-school suspension (ISS).

Student will receive warning from CHS administration and warning will be logged.

- 2) Second Violation: Students may do one of three things:
 - A. Students will correct the dress code violation or
 - B. Students will call home for a change of clothes
 - C. If the student cannot correct the dress code violation or call home for a change of clothes, the student will finish the remainder of the day in in-school suspension (ISS).

Student will receive **1 Day of ISS** from CHS administration and the 2nd Dress code violation will be logged. **(IF THE STUDENT MUST REMAIN IN ISS FOR THE DAY THAT DOES NOT COUNT AS A DAY SERVED IN ISS FROM THE CONSEQUENCE GIVEN.)**

- 3) Third Violation: Students may do one of three things:
 - A. Students will correct the dress code violation or
 - B. Students will call home for a change of clothes.
 - C. If the student cannot correct the dress code violation or call home for a change of clothes, the student will finish the remainder of the day in in-school suspension (ISS).

Student will receive **3 Days of ISS** from CHS administration and the 3rd Dress code violation will be logged. **(IF THE STUDENT MUST REMAIN IN ISS FOR THE DAY THAT DOES NOT COUNT AS A DAY SERVED IN ISS FROM THE CONSEQUENCE GIVEN.)**

- 4) Fourth Violation: Students may do one of three things:
 - A. Students will correct the dress code violation or
 - B. Students will call home for a change of clothes.
 - C. If the student cannot correct the dress code violation or call home for a change of clothes, the student will finish the remainder of the day in in-school suspension (ISS). Student will receive 5 Days of ISS from CHS administration and the 4th Dress code violation will be logged.

After the fourth violation, all dress code violations will be labeled as willful disobedience, and the student will receive progressive measures of OSS (ex. 5th offense = 1 Day OSS, 6th offense = 3 days OSS, and so on).
