Sharpe Elementary school encourages parental involvement through the following strategies:

Parents with specific talents are asked to act as resource persons to complement and extend the instructional program through volunteer services.

Parents are provided surveys and other information-gathering instruments to express their ideas and concerns.

Parents are encouraged to join and be actively involved in the Parent-Teacher Organization.

Parents are provided a Family Instructional Resource Cart in the school which provides instructional materials for help at home.

Parents are provided Parents' Center information and they are requested to attend parent training sessions.

TITLE I INVOLVEMENT

The following parental involvement activities at Sharpe Elementary School comply with guidelines required by Title I:

1. An annual meeting is held during and after school to inform parents about the Title I program and parental rights. Parents are surveyed for information on topics and types of future parents meeting. Parents are also provided with a question and answer period for discussion and evaluation form for suggestions during each meeting.
2. Informational meetings and/or instructional workshops are held monthly during and after school to provide hands-on experiences in the instructional process. Information on Sharpe's School –wide Title I Program, Parents Right to Know, timely information about parent involvement programs is also included in all meeting.
3. The Parent/Student/Teacher/School Compact outlines how students, teachers, parents, and the principal share responsibility for improved student achievement.
4. The Family Instructional Resource Center provides instructional materials for parents to help their children at home.

5. The Professional School Counselor conducts parent workshops and involvement activities to increase parental awareness and acceptance of their roles and responsibilities in the education of their children.
6. Parents serve as resource persons by sharing their expertise as it relates to grade level units of study. Parents also serve as volunteers by reading to students, helping the classroom teacher, communicating to other parents and supervising field trips. Parents serve on the PTO, the school-based Leadership Council and the district's Parents' Assembly.
7. Parents visit the classrooms and attend after school extra curricular activities.
8. To communicate and keep parents informed in a timely manner, Sharpe conducts Back to School Night (handbook, policies compacts), Parent-Teacher Conference days, RTI2 response reports, school message board, monthly school calendars weekly progress reports, flyers and newsletters and electronic progress reports to describe and explain the curriculum. Family Data Nights are held to inform parents how they can help their child at home on tested skill, the forms of assessments used and the proficiency levels students are expected to meet.
